Signs and symbols in our local community: After finding a 'no dogs allowed sign' on the school gate we have taken an interest in looking at different signs around the community. We went on a 'discover and see' walk to look at all the different signs we could find. **Recycling:** Some of the children have taken a keen interest in learning about recycling after a group discussion about our recycling bins in nursery.
