Health and Wellbeing

We have been working on a new Getting It Right For Every Child interactive wall display. We have been asking the children what they know about the health and wellbeing indicators which are Safe, Healthy, Achieving, Nurtured, Active, Responsible, Respected and Included. The children have been telling us their views and matching the indicators to the pictures on the wall. They have really embraced this and are enjoying looking at all the photos.

Learning Across the Curriculum

We have been offering daily table top game opportunities with an adult to guide and support. The children have really enjoyed this opportunity and have played all sorts of games including pairs, snap dominoes, bingo, lotto and many more. They have been developing their sharing and turn taking skills and learning how to follow game play rules.

Literacy and English

The children have taken a real interest in writing their own names and copying their friend's names from their name cards. Some of the children have also been practising early phonics and telling us the starting sounds of various words/ names. We intend to put a bigger focus on name writing as part of our transition to P1 topic this term.

Numeracy and Maths
