Literacy

We are continuing to work on spelling in class and for homework. This will in turn help us with our writing.

We will continue to use Oxford Reading Tree reading books. We will also do a block of nonfiction reading after the February break. Please continue with the reading challenge and note down all the books you read at home.

We are now going to move onto poetry, instructions and also leaflets which we will link to our topic work.

Numeracy and Maths

We will continue to explore numbers to 30 and beyond. We will also be working on different addition and subtraction strategies. We will give numeracy tasks for homework using the flash cards the children already have. This will be outlined on the P2 LOL. In maths, we will be learning about data and analysis and we will then move onto money after the February break. Our work in maths is very practical with lots of hands on experience.

Interdisciplinary Learning

This term we will be working on many science based topics which fit in nicely with science week in school during w/b 23.01.17.

Our topics are "Water" and "Materials" before the February break. After the February break, we will be working on "Dental Health" and "Healthy Eating".

We would encourage children to bring in any items related to our class topic work to allow us the opportunity to discuss and explore further.
