## Literacy <br> We are continuing to work on spelling and grammar in class. This will in turn help us with our writing. In grammar we will be working on nouns, verbs, adjectives and adverbs. Spelling will be part of our LOL. <br> We will continue to read fiction books for the remainder of the year. Please continue with the reading challenge and note down all the books you read at home. <br> We are now going to move onto letter writing and newspaper articles as well as reports this will link to our topic work.

## Numeracy and Maths

We will continue to explore numbers up to 100. We will continue to work on different addition and subtraction strategies as well as making links in our numeracy learning. We will give numeracy tasks as part of our LOL.
We will also be working on counting in intervals of $2 s, 5 s, 10 s$ and beyond. We will also be doing different problem solving activities thinking about strategies we can use.

In maths we will be learning about time and fractions. Our work in maths is very practical with lots of hands on experience.

## Topic

This term we will be working on Egyptians. This is a topic the classes chose last term. We are very excited to begin this and are going on a school trip to the museum which will compliment this work.
We will have lots of practical activities for our Egyptian topic and may need some parent helpers throughout!
Our final topic will be weather. We will be making weather instruments and recording weather data. We would encourage children to bring in any items related to our class topic work.

## Health \& Wellbeing

Our PE days for this term are Monday and Tuesday. Please ensure that children have their gym kit on these days. Gym kits can be kept in school for the full term and should consist of shorts, a t-shirt and good fitting indoor shoes. Girls should ensure hair is tied back for PE.
