## Literacy

Our writing this term will start with a focus on imaginative writing, followed by discursive/persuasive writing and finish with some newspaper articles.

In reading, we return to our work with fiction texts. Our focus in this final term will be tools for reading and we hope to look at a whole class novel study.
In talking and listening, we will use our reading skill - finding and using information - to aid our discussions.

## Numeracy and Maths

This term we will continue to focus on number word sequences and numerals up to 30 , up to 100 or counting in groups. We will continue developing our skills in addition and subtraction with 2 digit numbers. We will also further progress our work on sharing and grouping to strengthen our knowledge of multiplying and dividing. In Maths, we will continue our work on Money, before looking at the concept of Chance and Uncertainty and followed by a focus on Time.

## Interdisciplinary Learning (Topic)

This year is Cornbank's $50^{\text {th }}$ anniversary and we will be finding out about our school's history as well as taking part in lots of celebrations in June.
It is very apt therefore that our topic this term will be The 1960s. We'll be learning all about schooling, houses and popular culture from this decade.

## Health and Wellbeing

This term we will be looking at a range of circle time topics. Giving the opportunity for pupils to discuss their own experiences and share the impact of positive choices.
Our PE days for this term are Tuesday and Wednesday. On a Tuesday, our focus will be on accuracy and technique through athletics and striking/fielding games. Wednesdays are with our P.E. specialist, Mrs Jones.
