Lit<u>eracy</u>

We will continue to embed the spelling patterns we are learning, encouraging the children to use these in writing as much as possible. Handwriting will be a focus this term.

We will focus on Scottish stories, looking at skills to do with setting, plot and characters, as well as comparing stories and justifying our likes and dislikes.

Through our Egyptians topic we will revisit non -fiction reading skills too.

Numeracy and Maths

In Numeracy, we will continue using strategies we have learned so far. We will also begin to look at subtraction and will take a closer look at place value and how numbers are constructed.

We will begin to use Basic Maths facts games and fun timed tests to develop our fast recall of numbers facts. This is used across the school and the children really enjoy it!

In Maths, we will look at Time, focusing on days, months and seasons as well as consolidating half past and o'clock times.

Interdisciplinary Learning

We will begin the term with a focus on Scotland leading up to Burn's day and our ceilidh celebrations in school. We will look closely at our heritage and culture through dance, songs and food. Following on from this we will celebrate diversity by learning about Chinese New Year and the traditions associated with it.

Finally this term we will finish with our main topic, which will be The Egyptians. This will compare our lives with people in the past and will give many opportunities for art, drama and music, culminating in our shared assembly.
