## Literacy

We will continue with our spelling patterns each week in class. As well as this we will be having a focus on spelling common words so that we can transfer these into our writing.

### Numeracy/Maths

In numeracy we will continue to develop our skills in addition and subtraction using different strategies. We will also progress with our work on sharing and grouping and apply this to division and multiplication problems.

In Maths we will begin working on money including coin identification, paying for items and giving change from varying amounts. We will also do some work on measure, hopefully getting outdoors to do this!

It is very apt therefore that our topic this term will be The 1960s. In this topic we will be comparing life in Scotland in the sixties to the lives we have now.
