Literacy

We will continue to use the Reading Box this term, which allows children to work on Reading Comprehension at their own individual levels. Our novel study will be on the book 'Harry The Poisonous Centipede' by Lynne Reid Banks.

Research from books/the Internet and also note-taking will also feature quite heavily this term, as we research our topics.

Numeracy/Maths

In Numeracy we will be consolidating our addition and subtraction strategies which we have learned in previous terms and will be beginning work on Fractions. There will be revision of the 2,3,4,5 and 10 times tables.

In Maths, we will be working on Time, specifically calculating the duration of activities and will be working on Length, Capacity and Weight in Measure.

We have two topics to study this term. Our first is The Human Body and The Senses, where we will be learning about the major organs, the composition of our body and how it works and the controlling of germs.

Our second topic will be Food and Farming. In this topic we will be learning about the journeys which our foods take, what types of food are grown in Scotland and how we can make healthy food choices.
