In Maths, we will be working on fractions and will be working on Length, Capacity and Weight in Measure.

We will be focussing on school and home life, toys, music, foods, TV shows, dances and fashion. It will be a very exciting topic and you will see some of what we have learned about this topic, at our class assembly.
