Literacy

Our writing this term will be mainly functional, reporting on events to do with the Scottish Wars of Independence. In reading, we will be looking at a variety of skills linked to our topic, including evaluating sources, taking notes and looking at bias. In French we will be learning to describe clothing and appearance.

Numeracy/Maths

This term will focus on fractions and decimals and we will continue to consolidate all learning in P5, particularly multiplication and division, as well as looking at applying our learning in word problems. In maths we will be learning more about 2D and 3D shape and angles.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Our exciting last topic this term is the Scottish Wars of Independence where the children will have the opportunity to learn not only the historical events, but how to source and organise information independently. We would also like the children to prepare a short talk on a chosen aspect of this topic; information for this will follow.
