October to Christmas will be a busy term for P6. We are looking forward to Scottish week, our drumming performance and a Christmas Pantomime.

Literacy

Our reading will take the form of literature circles. Pupils will be given a portion of their novel to read and a written task based on this each week. In French we will continue to develop our reading and writing skills and will begin to work with our new Language assistant, Lorry.

Maths/Numeracy.

In numeracy, we will continue to work with 4 digit numbers in all 4 processes (including mental strategies for multiplication and division) and times tables. We will extend our understanding of time and Coordinates (within 4 quadrants for some pupils).

Interdisciplinary Learning.

Our topic this term is "The Body". Science is still discovering how amazing our bodies are and we need to look after them! We will look at several body systems including the reproductive system. Changes in both body and mind that come with hormones and puberty will be explained. We will also look closely at the proportions of the human body and do some life drawings of hands in our art sessions.

Health and Wellbeing.

We are receiving a block of rugby training in addition to a session with the P.E specialist each week. Our work on the body should inform the pupils on what is needed to maintain a healthy lifestyle. Pupils benefited greatly from their bike training.
