We have an action packed few months ahead of us, which started with a fabulous camp at Benmore! We will also be having a student, Miss Brown, working with the class for 6 weeks.

## Literacy

This term, we will be focusing on reading for information, particularly in terms of recognising and using the features of nonfiction texts. Our writing will be centred around persuasive texts of different sorts. We will have an opportunity to experience some German instead of French.

## Maths/Numeracy.

Our maths this term will include angles. Using three figure bearings will also be introduced.

We will continue to practise and extend our mental and written numeracy skills in all four processes and in problemsolving.

# Interdisciplinary Learning.

We will continue to look at issues involving inter-personal relationships and mental wellbeing through "Cool in School" and are examining aspects of personal safety both in the real world and online through a number of activities, including "Keeping Myself Safe".

We will be looking at space and our place in the solar system as our science topic.

Technology will include the design and making of a rocket.
