Literacy

We have completed our novel study of Holes written by Louis Sachar. This term the class will be working in their reading groups focusing on finding and using information to complete different activities. We will also be reading non-fiction texts to find and use information for our topic work.

In writing, P7 will be learning how to write reports and leaflets which will link to our topic for this term.

Numeracy/Maths

In numeracy, we have been focusing on using decimals in different calculations and contexts. We are now moving onto learning how to work out different calculations involving fractions.

In maths, P7 will be learning about measure with Mrs Stevenson.
