Literacy

The format of spelling has changed slightly. The children sit a 'pre-test' of all the spelling words, which then determines which spelling group they will be in each week. We have tried this before the holiday and the children seem to prefer this format.

This term, the children will be moving onto poetry with Mrs Stevenson.

Numeracy

This term we are moving onto algebra. We are focusing on applying and extending what they already know in different contexts.

The children will continue with measure with Mrs Stevenson and will soon move onto 2D and 3D shape.

Interdisciplinary Learning

We have completed two out of the three steps to achieve our John Muir award. The children enjoyed learning about planting different types of apple trees and are now conserving them as part of the school grounds. The third step will be completed at camp.

The class will be looking at Scotland as our topic at the beginning of this term before moving onto World War II in February.
