Welcome back to Term 2! This is another busy term for Primary 7. It was lovely to see you all at the parental consultations last term. We hope this term the children will continue to rise to the high standards they achieved last term.

Literacy

This term we will be doing a whole class novel study on 'Parvana's Journey'. This is the second in a series, which follows on from the book we read in Term 1. Our writing and reading lessons will both be related to the section of the book we have read that week. After current homework novels have finished there will be no set reading homework. This term we will also carry on with weekly spelling lists tailored to individual needs.

Numeracy

To begin the term we will continue our learning on fractions. This will include finding a fraction of a whole number and ordering fractions. We will then move onto decimals and place value.

In maths we will be looking at angle, symmetry and transformation.

Interdisciplinary Learning

Our topic this term is Religion, Peace and Conflicts. This will link to our class novel which discusses the effects of modern day conflict in Afghanistan. Through this, we will look at: bullying, forgiveness and reconciliation, United Nations, Just War Theory, Pacifism and nuclear weapons. We will also be doing stand alone seasonal activities on the run up to Christmas.

Health & Wellbeing

Both P7 classes enjoyed their visit to the Risk Factory last term. The theme of identifying potential risks will be continued this term through follow up activities provided by the Risk Factory. In P.E. we will be focussing on improving our fitness. Nearer the end of term we will begin Scottish Dancing in preparation for our upcoming Christmas Party.
