Primary 2 Term 4 Newsletter

Welcome back to the final term of Primary 2! We have lots of learning and fun activities coming up this term.

Literacy

We will continue to embed the spelling patterns we are learning, encouraging the children to use these in writing as much as possible. Handwriting will be a focus this term.

In Grammar we will be learning all about nouns, verbs, adjectives and alphabetical order.

During Writing we will be learning about a variety of genre including using instructions, letters and imaginative writing. Writing will link to our topic.

Numeracy and Maths

In Numeracy, we will continue using strategies we have learned so far. We will also begin to look at fractions.

We will continue to use Basic Maths facts games and fun timed tests to develop our fast recall of numbers facts.

In Maths, we will begin with measure looking at weight, length, height and volume. We will also be learning all about money, including using change and the various different methods of payment that can be used.

Interdisciplinary Learning

We will begin the term with a focus on Hinduism. We will explore stories about Hindu beliefs and customs as well as learning about the festivals 'Holi' and 'Rakhi'. We will begin to understand how Hindu beliefs are put into action in people's lives and communities too.

We will then have Health Fortnight where we will revise our knowledge of healthy eating and take a closer look at recipes linked to our instructional writing.

We will finish the term with our topic of "Woodlands". We will learn to recognise the impact of science on the environment and learn to express our opinions of environmental issues. We will have lots of opportunities to classify/sort different plants and animals as well as explore our local woodland.

Health & Wellbeing

Our PE days for this term are Tuesday and Wednesday. Please ensure that children have full gym kit on these days including a hair bobble to tie back long hair.

We will continue to revisit Cool in School this term as well having weekly circle times focussing on friendship. We will also be learning about internet safety.
