# Literacy

In Writing, we will be focussing on imaginative writing, creating instructions and poetry writing. We will continue to develop our Listening and Talking skills across a variety of curricular areas.

# Numeracy and Maths

In numeracy this term we will be looking at place value and the importance of zero. This will involve being able to describe the link between a digit, its place and its value.

In Maths, we will be completing our work on Shape before going on to look at Measure and Data Handling.

### Interdisciplinary Learning

We are continuing our Titanic topic into the beginning of Term 2. Afterwards, we will be starting another topic entitled Farm to Fork, where we will be exploring the journey food takes before it reaches us. This topic has key links to Health & Wellbeing and Technologies; however, we will also link our learning within Writing. Primary 4 will be taking part in Science Week and will share their learning at an assembly.

#### Health & Wellbeing

Primary 4 will continue to visit Mrs Jones for P.E. on a Thursday. Please ensure that children have their gym kit on this day.
