
Fiona M's **Numeracy** activity:

Diane's **Health and Wellbeing** activity:



Tuesday


Stacey's Literacy activity: Drawing Faces

Wednesday


Leah's Literacy activity: **Sensory letter hunt**

Susan's Numeracy activity:

Directions: Take turns to hide a toy or teddy. Give the other players directions. See if they can follow them to find the toy.
