Health & Wellbeing

Primary 6 spent the first few weeks concentrating on establishing our Class Charter. We have learned about what our rights are and how they relate to being safe in school.

We are continuing to use the outdoor space for PE. This term there will be a focus on fitness and team games. Outdoor spaces will be used across the curriculum. Please ensure your child wears appropriate foot wear and brings a jacket to school.

Literacy

We have started to engage with our class novel, *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe*. The children will engage in comprehension activities to deepen their understanding of the text.

In Writing, we will be focusing on creating imaginary stories with an emphasis on setting the scene and character descriptions.

To develop our Listening and Talking skills, we will engage in class discussions by contributing relevant ideas and building on the viewpoints of others.

Numeracy and Maths

We are recapping our work on times tables and number bonds. We will then focus on ordering, place value and rounding.

In Maths, we have recapped 2D and 3D shape. We will build on our knowledge of shape properties. Children will gain an understanding of angles and the terms circumference and diameter.

Additional Information

Due to the increase amount of hand washing, children can bring in their own hand sanitiser. This can be left in their trays. There are hand washing facilities available for others.
