Literacy

This term we will be continuing with our reading in class and at home. We will be focusing on reading strategies, increasing our confidence and developing our fluency. We will be working on our comprehension skills.

We will continue to learn a new spelling pattern each week and have a focus on common words. In grammar we will be looking at vowels, consonants and joining words.

For writing we are focussing on report writing, letter writing and poetry, which will be linked to our topic where possible.

Numeracy and Maths

This term we will continue to explore different methods for addition and subtraction.

We will also continue to work on our formation, number recognising and identifying numbers.

In Maths we will begin the term focussing on pattern and symmetry. Following on from this we will be looking at data handling and this will be linked to our weather topic.

Interdisciplinary Learning (IDL)

Our main topic this term will be 'World Weather' where we will be learning about how the weather changes throughout the seasons and how the weather varies across the world. Within this topic we will be looking at water, different water states and the water cycle. We will cover a range of curricular areas through this topic.

Health & Wellbeing

This term we will continue to refer to Zones of Regulation, growth mindset and encourage a positive attitude to learning. We will also look at our Cool in School approach. We will take part in regular Circle Time to explore concepts further.
