Numeracy and Maths

In term 1 we focused on place value, ordering and rounding numbers. Now we have begun to look at the four operations $(+ - x \div)$ and the written methods we can use as strategies. In maths, we will continue to explore the topic of time. You can support this at home by asking children to read analogue / digital time and work out time durations.
