Health & Wellbeing

P.E will continue to be weekly with myself (Thursdays) and we will use a mix of indoor and outdoor facilities. Please remember to bring jackets and suitable footwear!

The class will also have some P.E sessions with Mrs Jones on Fridays - dates will be emailed for this term.

A reminder that Primary 6 will start our Sex and Relationships topic this term. P6 and P7 will continue to learn about real life risks and how to deal with them. The Keeping Myself Safe programme will also be delivered.

Literacy

This term we are developing our imaginative writing with a focus on description and features of writing including metaphors, similes and personification for creating interesting and exciting stories. We are developing our inference skills by investigating picture stimulus which we are using as prompts for our writing.

We will be continuing with our reading groups and will be taking on the roles of question maker, illustrator, summariser, passage picker and word wizard to explore the novels we are reading.

In spelling, the children are undertaking weekly activities based on the Jolly Grammar progression for words suited to individual needs.



Numeracy and Maths

This term our numeracy focus will be fractions, decimals and percentages. We will be developing our knowledge of these, both individually, and exploring the links between them. We will be continuing to develop our basic facts knowledge and recall to help us with trickier aspects of our maths and numeracy work.

In Maths, we will be focusing on money. We will be building on our existing skills and using these in real life contexts, such as budgeting for buying new playground equipment and fundraising for camp. More information on our fundraising to follow!
