Literacy

In Writing, we are learning about newspaper articles and reports, we will look closely at the different features and write our own. Our writing will be linked to our natural disasters topic.

Each week we will be learning a new spelling pattern, which we will do lots of work on in class and we will be continuing to do our weekly dictations.

We are also going to be doing a novel study, which links to our natural disasters topic.

Numeracy and Maths

This term in numeracy, we will continue to work on place value involving decimal numbers as well as looking at different addition and subtraction strategies linked to word problems. There will be the chance to do some more algebra. We will also do some times table practice ready for a big focus in Term 2.

We will continue to work on our quick recall of number facts through our basic maths facts programme.

In maths, we will work on money and budgeting.

Interdisciplinary Learning

After a busy start with House Election campaigns, Renewable Energy focus and running the Book Fair, we have now begun our topic on Earth Structures and natural disasters. There is already a buzz of excitement around our new topic. Children will learn how and where disasters form, the impact on the landscape and the impact on human lives. Children are encouraged to bring in anything linked to our topic to share with the class. In December, we will have a Christmas focus and we will be helping to run the stalls at our Cornbank Christmas Fair.

Health & Wellbeing

Our indoor P.E. day this term will be a Wednesday with Mrs. Chatham, we are hoping to do an outdoor PE slot on a Tuesday with Mrs. Murphy (weather permitting). We will be working on Hockey with Mrs. Chatham and Basketball with Mrs. Murphy. Children will have the chance to try out for our P6-7 basketball team this term and our P6-7 hockey team in term 2.
