### P1 Teachers/ELC Staff

Miss Denholm, Mrs Davies and Mrs Macgregor are our current P1 teachers and Emma Daly is our SEYP - these staff and the ELC team will work to support the transition into P1 through April, May and June this year









The process of transition occurs over time beginning well before children start school and extending to the point where learners and families feel a sense of belonging to the school and when educators recognise this sense of learning

## Transition



- Awaiting final confirmation of numbers for children starting P1 following deferral and placement request process
- You must register your child at your catchment school - placement requests follow later (April/May)
- Transition will start after the Easter break
- Early Years staff and P1 teachers will liaise to share information during this time

## Transition



- All children will take part in the Midlothian wide 'Midmouse' project
- ELC/Partnership Nurseries and P1 teachers will liaise to share information and arrange visits to ensure a smooth transition

- Welcome booklets for learners




