This term in reading, the children will begin working in their reading groups. It is essential that everyone completes their assigned reading homework in order to form their answers to discussions in the classroom.

In writing, we will be working on imaginative and personal story writing.

Numeracy and Maths

We will be continuing to develop our multiplication and division strategies this term, using problem solving as a context. We will also be working on prime numbers, factors and multiples. We will be consolidating what we have learned so far this year.

In maths we will be covering aspects of shape with a particular focus on area, perimeter and volume. We will be looking to use the above topics in context, working on our problem-solving skills and using written questions to challenge our thinking and expand our mathematical vocabulary.
