Spotlight Strategy - 'Zones of Regulation'

The Zones of Regulation is a tool to support learners in developing long term self-regulation skills. This is visible in each class through the display of 4 zones represented by different colours – red, blue, yellow and green.

Children have been taught to identify emotions in each zone and are able to move their picture or name depending on how they are feeling. It encourages learners to become aware of their emotions, build awareness of others and develop coping strategies. If children are able to recognize when they are becoming less regulated, we are able to do something about it to get to a better place.

Blue Zone	Green Zone	Yellow Zone	Red Zone
sad sick tired	moving slowly calm feeling ok focused ready to learn	frustrated worried silly/wiggly excited loss of some control	mad/angry worried yelling/hitting elated out of control
