### Literacy

We will be continuing with our usual routine of weekly reading groups; homework chapters are posted on Google Classroom. Our weekly spelling patterns will continue with the pattern being introduced on a Monday followed by a spelling test on a Friday.

Our writing work this term will be based on our new topic; The Olympics, from which we will be writing reports and creating imaginative and persuasive pieces of writing. We will also be using our topic to develop our reading for information skills. Our weekly grammar work will also continue to help us 'up level' our writing.

### Numeracy and Maths

We will continue to consolidate and build on previous learning this term, revisiting addition and subtraction strategies, fractions, decimals and percentages, and multiplication and division strategies.

In maths we will focus on building on our knowledge of money and time.

Any times table practice at home is encouraged and appreciated!

### Interdisciplinary Learning

This term our topic is The Olympics. Hopefully this will be enjoyed by the class in the lead up to the 2024 Paris Olympics! We are going to be covering a range of activities looking at; the history of the Olympics, comparing some of the first events to modern day events, notable Olympians, different Olympic sports, and looking at the effort that goes into planning an Olympic Games event.

### Health & Wellbeing

Our P.E. days this term continue to be on a Tuesday and Thursday. Pupils should have a P.E. kit available to them in school, these can be kept on their pegs.

Our focus for PE this term will be different athletic activities in the lead up to Sports Day.
