Just like that, we are in the last term of Primary 7! What a quick year it has been, we are all looking forward to a busy but memorable final term of primary school!

Literacy

In Reading, we will explore a class novel-Journey to the River Sea, by Eva Ibbotson. Being set in the Amazon Rainforest, this a natural link with our ongoing Rainforest topic. We will focus on features of language and learn to recognise techniques that influence the reader e.g. word choice and emotive language.

In Writing, we are focussing on building imaginative pieces using elements of character, setting and plot.

In Listening and Talking we will be rehearsing our show parts in groups and scenes, learning to project our voices and use expression when speaking aloud.

Numeracy and Maths

In numeracy we will be working on fractions, decimals and percentages. We will be looking at the links between these three concepts and linking this learning to using these concepts in everyday life. In Maths, we will focus on area, perimeter and volume. We will be looking to use the above topics in context, working on our problem-solving skills and using written questions to challenge our thinking.

We will continue to consolidate times tables and also work on our Basic Maths Facts programme.

Interdisciplinary Learning

We will continue our Rainforest topic looking at recent scientific advances in medicine and how the Rainforest has been part of that.

Our big focus will be rehearsing our parts and songs for our upcoming P7 show- 'Blast From the Past'! Costume letters will be coming home shortly. Please let us know if you need any help sourcing anything for your child's costume as soon as possible.

Health & Wellbeing

Our P.E. days will continue to be on a Tuesday and a Wednesday this term. Please bring your PE kit into school to be kept on your peg.
